



INTERIM DIRECTIVE

RELATING TO:	Prohibited Uses on the Legislative Precinct <i>Policy 6015 – Public Use of Grounds</i>
ISSUED ON:	April 30, 2024

This interim directive is issued in accordance with the *Legislative Assembly Policy Framework* to address a gap in *Policy 6015 – Public Use of Grounds*, and has application to Members of the Legislative Assembly, staff, and the public. This interim directive will provide clarity on prohibited uses – specifically, certain activities – on the Legislative Precinct.

Policy 6015 – Public Use of Grounds has a provision prohibiting political or partisan events, activities, and celebrations on the Legislative Precinct “if scheduled to be held during an election, a by-election, or a referendum campaign.”

Through this interim directive, the following prohibitions are added, applicable at all times:

1. Political party branding and advertising cannot be used or displayed on the Legislative Precinct.
2. Political parties cannot host any electoral events, activities, and celebrations on the Legislative Precinct, including party policy and platform announcements and candidate announcements.

In accordance with the *Legislative Assembly Policy Framework*, this interim directive remains in place until October 30, 2024, or until a revised *Policy 6015 – Public Use of Grounds* is approved by the Legislative Assembly Management Committee and comes into effect, whichever is sooner.
